An update from the WCDEFA brings our organization new opportunities in the review of CWD research. Our organization looks to join the collaborative support of the Peck Farm research along with NADeFA and DBC. This research initiative will add a bull elk into the CWD study review as the farm approaches its 5th year of CWD exposure as outlined in our summer update. Research to date shows negative impacts of environmental contaminations that suppress a deer's immune system to a point of debilitation resulting in development of CWD as an end life stage disease process. Through monitoring these negative environmental organisms we've looked to optimize our dietary and water supports of these deer to stave off negative health consequences. Though initially we lost deer who succumbed to CWD in this study, we learned immensely from their deaths about the disease process which has eluded our industry in the past. To date, we have been successful in re-establishing reproduction and survival of whitetail deer offspring in the last 2 breeding cycles. CWD was first reported on this farm nearly 5 years ago, and our research is showing that we are on a positive pathway to understanding this disease process. Our hope is to be able to beat CWD in deer.
